











Ancient Cities of Egypt

City	Blurb	Image
Thebes	Was inhabited around 3200 B.C. and is the site of the major temples of Luxor and Karnak	
Abu Simbel	Houses incredible monuments of Ancient Egypt, including the temples of Ramses II	
Memphis	Capital of the Old Kingdom. The temple of Ptah, the palace of Apries, and two huge statues of Ramses II are found here.	
Kahun	City erected by overseers and workmen as they were building the pyramid of Al-Lahun. Abandoned after the construction of the pyramid.	
Giza	Most famous for the pyramids of Khufu and the Great Sphinx. Has Numerous private tomb complexes.	

Aswan	The first town in Egypt. The valuable granite rock is found here.	
Sakkara	Home to Pharaoh Djoser's step pyramid	
Alexandria	Founded by Alexander the Great. Considered on the seven wonders of the ancient world.	
Dashur	Reading the Red Pyramid? This is where you will find it!	
Abydos	prominent sacred city. One of the most important sites for Archeology.	
Edfu	The temple of Horus, one of the best preserved temples found here.
